Accreditation

JIC is one of 94 members of the Association of Exchanged Life Ministries (www.aelm.org). AELM annually evaluates the minimum theological requirements for Advanced Discipleship Training (ADT).

ADT focuses on personally equipping each student for discipling other Christians in his or here sphere of influence. ADT does not qualify for credit toward licensed counseling.

ADT does qualify as a 3-hour credit for the course entitled "Biblical Counseling Practicum" for the Master of Arts in Bib-

Tuition

\$1,700 total, breakdown as follows:

- \$100 for initial Romans 5-8 study (open to the public)
- \$0 for Orientation
- \$200 for each of the 8 subsequent teaching weekends

Note: ADT students are ministry partners with JIC because 100% of tuition goes to ministering to others. None of the tuition goes to JIC staff salaries. Full-time JIC staff members are missionaries who raise their own support through personal ministry partners.

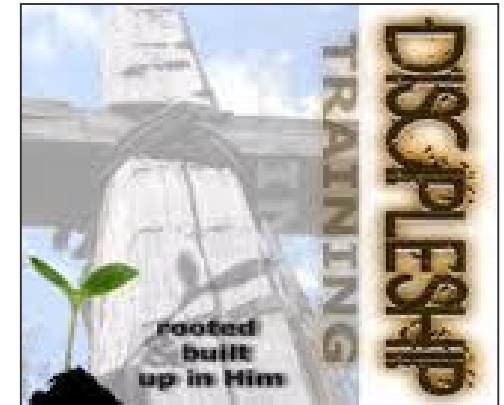


Journey in Christ

Description

The objectives of Advanced Discipleship Training (ADT) include equipping each student to grow in the following:

1. Understanding of the presence and power of God through personally appropriating the message of the cross (1 Corinthians 1:18).
2. Empathetic interpersonal skills for communicating biblical truths in discipling others.
3. Articulating a biblical philosophy of discipleship.
4. Understanding of ethical and legal issues in discipling others.

Foundational Biblical truths are taught in a class framework within a safe environment of peers to encourage group discussion and personal application.



Prerequisites

1. Completion of 8-hour *Grace Life Conference* (available on DVDs).
2. Submittal of ADT application forms, including 3 references.
3. Interview with a JIC staff member.

Personal Counseling & Supervision

Each student is assigned a JIC staff member as a supervisor/mentor. A minimum of 7 hours of supervision is required. Memorization of selected Scriptures is a part of the mentoring.

Supervisors take each student personally through the discipleship process he or she is being trained to take others through.

Counseling Training

Each student will be provided with up to 25 hours hands-on training via JIC counseling/teaching observations, review of counseling sessions via DVDs, and in-class practice.
